will be able to do so by adding a new antenna to an existing radio tower and adding a new radio frequency - 88.3FM! That's good for Clinton and for you when you're driving in this area. Even better, during research it was discovered that Wapella, Heyworth, and other nearby towns will also benefit from that same antenna and frequency! By this fall, Catholic Spirit Radio will be heard on 88.3 FM.

Purchasing and installation costs for such an endeavor are a minimum of \$15,000. Catholic Spirit Radio is non-profit and doesn't have all the necessary funds to make this happen. So, they are asking our parish communities to help by financially contributing to the project. 
