Catholic Spirit Radio (CSR) Network Antenna Update

As you recall, this antenna will be attached to an existing tower in Clinton and will allow many more people in our surrounding communities to **RADIO** hear Catholic radio on the new frequency of 88.3 FM. This special antenna costs about

\$15,000 to be built, shipped, and installed.

Donations toward the project were given to the Spirit representatives on the day of their presentation on January 21st. Other donations were mailed directly to the station, dropped into the parish collection basket, or given online through the CSR website. As of February 12th, St. Patrick parishioners have contributed \$7,386!

It's not too late to donate if you haven't had the chance! Any amount will help this project reach fruition. Your continued prayers are appreciated, too. All donations are tax deductible because CSR is a volunteer-run charitable, non-profit organization.




