

Missionary Co-Op Appeal for Tanzania's Bukoba Diocese Seminarians Sunday, April 14th

Bukoba Catholic Diocese is one of 34 dioceses found in Tanzania, East Africa. It is in the northwestern part of the country on the shores of Lake Victoria. The diocese has 40 parishes with more than 300 outstations. Most are in underdeveloped rural areas with people relying on subsistence small scale farming activities. Meet-

ing the expenses of this diocese with its institutions is a considerable challenge. Because of this, the Diocesan Bishop of Bukoba, Bishop Jovitus Francis Mwijage, has requested participation in the Missionary Cooperative Program and Appeal in the Diocese of Peoria. The purpose is to support the education and training of seminarians. The diocese is greatly blessed with vocations to the priesthood but is struggling to educate these future priests and asks for your generous support. The full formation of a seminarian to priesthood takes 8 years in which he studies Philosophy and Theology. The annual cost for educating one seminarian in Tanzania is USD \$2,500. Considering the financially poor state of diocesan families, there is an incredible challenge to support formation for more than 60 seminarians.

Father Derick will be making this appeal next Sunday. Please kindly consider your support for his home diocese in its struggle to provide workers for the Lord's vineyard and Shepherds of the Lord's flock.
