On this 61st anniversary of the *World Day of Prayer for Vocations*, also liturgically known as *Good Shepherd Sunday*, we are invited to pray for and promote all vocations. Initiated by Saint Paul VI during the Second Vatican Council in 1964, the purpose of this day is to help all of us respond to God's call and to <u>support in prayer all</u> <u>those who are discerning</u> how to best respond to the needs of today in the vocation God calls them to be.

Participating in parish life is a way individuals can discern their vocation and receive prayerful support from parishioners. It has been found that parishioners are more likely to encourage someone to discern their vocation than their own family members!

Will you make a special effort to ask the Lord for more vocations, especially to the priesthood and religious life?

-Encourage your children to consider a vocation as a priest or religious brother or sister.

-Pray a rosary for more young men and women to respond to God's call.

-Encourage youth to pray in any way possible. -Offer a Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament.

-Bring children before the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

-Keep priests and religious Sisters and Brothers, both living and dead, in your prayers.




